I want to take this opportunity to thank Rich and Jane Me-haffey for their efforts to make this year's PARC Flea Market another stellar event.

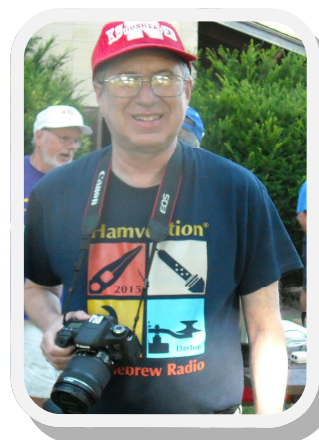

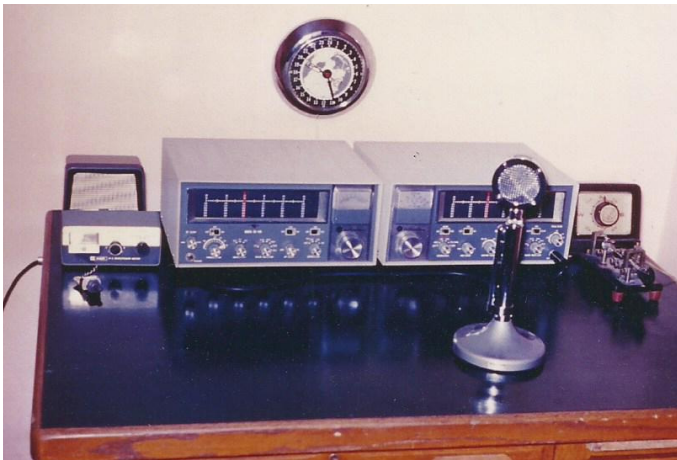

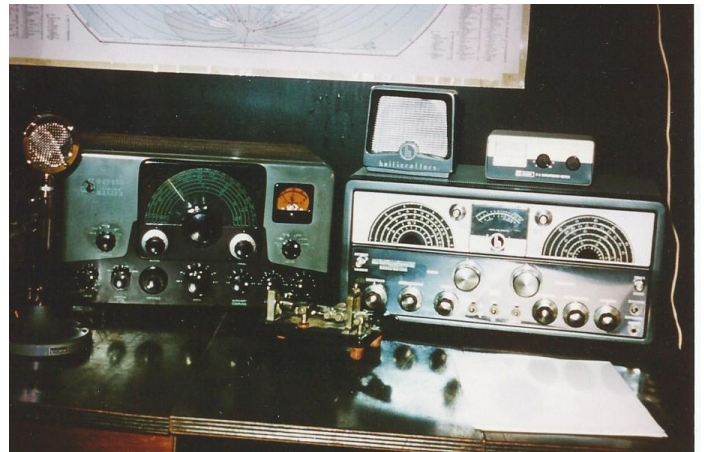

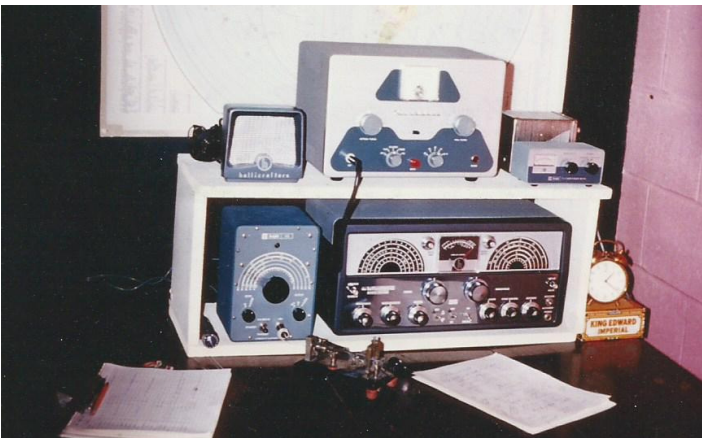
