PIONEER AMATEUR RADIO CLUB MINUTES MAY 23, 2019

The Pioneer Amateur Radio Club Meeting for May 23, 2019, was called to order at 7 PM by President Tony Renze, K00MH. He opened with a tribute to PARC member Larry Martens, K0SW, who died on April 30. 25 people were present, who introduced themselves.

MINUTES and TREASURER'S REPORT: The April minutes and May Treasurer's Report were approved as printed in the May *PARC News*.

MOTION to PAY BILLS: A check for \$50 was sent to Jarad Chrisman, KD0EFC for the rent for the 147.67 repeater. It had previously been approved. Darlene Hoffman, N0LOP spent \$29.99 for flowers for the K0SW funeral.

HOSPITALITY: Nothing to report.

EDUCATION: Nothing to report.

FIELD DAY: Scheduled for Izaak Walton League Park in Fremont on June 22-23, 2019. Don Renze, K00M Chairman. Set-up will be on around 2 PM. Probably 3-4 stations. BBQ grill is available. K00MH will stay all Saturday night. He also asks that people bringing laptops for logging have previously loaded N3FJP software. Family potluck at 6 PM on Saturday. Hot dogs, hamburgers, drinks, and utensils will be furnished. People are asked to bring a side dish.

CLUB CALL: Lance Hoffman, WN0L said that K0SW, belonging to Larry Martens, could be used during Field Day. He also moved that K0SW be obtained to use as the club call replacing K0JFN. Phil Bahl, KA0UNB seconded the motion, which was approved.

FLEA MARKET: Scheduled for North Bend on July 13, 2019. Chairman Rich Mehaffey, KB0ARZ. He reported that 17 tables have already been reserved. He handed out the most current fliers (green). Jane Mehaffey, KB0ZUN has mailed out the invitations. Magazine ads are in place. Steve Narans, WB0VNF will have a Silent Auction again. He has a few items left over from last year but will need more items at the June meeting. N0LOP will again have Darlene's Diner.

PICNIC: Scheduled for Sunday, September 22, 2019 at the Theophilus home. Dave Theophilus, W0NRW and Sharon Martens, KB0TVB Chairpersons.

CHRISTMAS PARTY: The Outer Limits in Valley is reserved for our party on Saturday, December 14, 2019 from 530 PM to 930 PM. Linda Kirchmann, W0ZIP Chairperson.

NET MANAGER: Mel Cunningham, K0VLA thanked everybody. He has 5 Net Control Operators. He would like to see more check-ins.

ARES: W0NRW reported on Dodge County Emergency Management training on Thursday evenings in June.

PUBLICITY: W0NRW reported that the meeting notice was printed in the *Fremont Tribune*. He will also handle the Field Day publicity.

OLD BUSINESS: Jarad Chrisman, KD0EFC reported that the 146.67 repeater will require a PL tone of 100 to access it, probably in July to cut down on intermod interference. He then will be able to open up the squelch control to a more reasonable figure. It is now set at 80%. The plan is to not leave anybody behind who might have old radios or who might need assistance in setting up the tone. (*on the May 29, 2 meter net, he also answered questions about the need for the switch and how it will be done*).

NEW BUSINESS: Fred Eriksen, KB0LF talked about the upcoming ARRL VHF Contest and the hope for increased participation by Nebraska stations. Steve Narans, WB0VNF gave a report on the Dayton Hamfest and the Fremont Flood Recovery efforts. There is a Thank-You dinner planned for 4 PM – 7 PM on June 23 at the Fremont Golf Club for those who helped during the Flood. W0NRW gave Kudos to Wes Chrisman, KD0PGV on his award as a Waterloo policeman during the Flood. N0LOP said that we need more Volunteer Examiners.

BOARD MEMBER: K00MH said we will need a new Board Member to replace K0SW. N0LOP volunteered to serve in the position, which was accepted.


DRAWING: The winner of \$10 was Lance Hoffman, WN0L.




