Nebraska YL Ham of the Year. Same qualifications as above, but for YL only.

Nebraska Young Ham of the Year. Same qualifications as above, EXCEPT that they be 18 years of age of YOUNGER.

Gwen Anderson KØGAA Memorial Award. The person who is nominated for this award is one that works behind the scenes to make everything work smoothly. Whether it be for a hamfest, hamvention, or even at your club or other events. They are the go to person that makes it happen.

The Skip Miller WØKVM Lifetime Achievement Award. This award is given to the individual who has been a ham radio operator for at least 25 years. He or she has been active during that time and has made contributions to the art of Ham Radio.

Special Service Award. This is a new awards category that was started last year. This is a person that vounteers his or her time to better the community at large. This individual uses his or her individual skills outside of Ham Radio. They might a person who mows their neighbors lawn, scoops snow, volunteers at a soup kitchen, teaches a person to read or to learn English as examples. They only qualification besides this is that they are ham radio operators.
