Two New Digitpeating Amateur Radio Satellites Approved For Launch

The International Amateur Radio Union has coordinated two European digipeating satellites that are scheduled to launch in fall 2023. At the Technical University of Kosice in Slovakia, satellite Veronika, a 1U CubeSat, is scheduled for launch on a Falcon 9 launcher in October 2023.

The satellite will be equipped with a 24/7 digipeater on two different bands, as well as experimental slow-scan digital video transmissions. There is an education and outreach mission planned to involve Slovak grammar and high schools, and to transmit special CW and AX.25 messages on several special occasions. The satellite will be equipped with a novel Attitude Determination and Control System subsystem, incluging electromagnetic actuators and a global navigation satellite system receiver. This will also help to identify the satellite during the first days and weeks of orbit.

The satellite will communicate using Spacemanics well known Murgas transceivers.
