W7UP and YL Set Up FT8 At Indian Cave State Park

AJ and I went to Indian Cave State Park on Friday and I set up an FT8 PITA station on the tailgate of the F150 at the cave parking lot.

I used the KX2 at 5 and 10 watts, a SignaLink USB and a Buddipole vertical antenna and made 14 FT8 contacts. Power was supplied by a Bioenno battery, Buddipole charge controller and Bioenno 40 watt solar panels. There was a cold wind blowing down the Missouri River, so the KX2 heat sink barely got warm at 10 watts.

I purchased a set of Buddipole antennas from WOMF before he passed away, and did not realize that I had purchased three separate antenna systems. I didn't have the antenna properly configured for the 20 meter PITA activation, so need to RTFM, set up the antennas, tune the antennas and keep proper notes.

At the end of the day, both AJ and I really enjoyed the outing and the vibrant fall colors. 73, Dan
